

# Prayer Net



## SETTING UP THE PRAYER STATION

### You'll need

- strips of coloured yarn or ribbons
- a net with holes large enough for tying on pieces of yarn
- surface from which to hang the net or on which to place the net
- container for strips
- instructions for visitors to the station (see next page)
- flat surface (table)



### To set up the station

- Lay out net, either on a flat surface or hanging from a vertical surface (wall, door).
  - Net should be draped on/close to the flat surface
- Place coloured strips in container.
- Place container and instructions for visitors on the flat surface.

## Instructions for visitors

Jesus' first followers were fishermen. Jesus called them to leave their nets and follow him.

***Why not take a piece of yarn and tie it into the net as a symbol of your renewed determination to follow Jesus?***

We all pray. We all ask for God's blessing. We all follow God's call.

***Return as often as you'd like to tie a piece of yarn as a symbol of a prayer. It can express the prayer of your heart without speaking a word.***

By rituals like this, we can come closer to the Holy Spirit who prays within us, "with sighs too deep for words." (Romans 8:26)
